This year the conference plays host to several keynote speakers. Dr. Kristie’s book “Finding Your True Self: A guide to Gender Acceptance” will be published in September 2018. She is also a licensed mental health counselor, licensed professional clinical counselor, licensed professional counselor, certified sex therapist, and certified addiction professional. She travels across the United States speaking about the needs of the LGBTQIA community.
